High School Athletic Admission

Rate Changes

\$5.00 for all events

Family Rate - \$15 (mom, dad, kids in school who live in their house)

Student Pass - \$25 (through 9/11); \$30 (9/12 to 9/18)
\$35 (anytime afterward)

Punch Pass - \$75 (good for 20 admissions)

Senior Citizens – free admission with a senior pass.

Athletic Schedules

To access the athletic schedules from the high school web page:

- Click on a sport above and it takes you to that schedule on High-SchoolSports.net. You can do many things with these schedules.
 - When in the schedule, you will notice that some schools are listed in blue. If you click on them, you will get a MAP to that school.
 - To the right of the schedule, is a "STATS" button in blue. If you click on this, it might give you MORE DETAILS about the event.
 - At the top of the schedule there are 4 tabs - 2-Day, Week, Month, Season. This gives you different ways to see the schedule.
 - On the 2-day listing, you will notice a green button on the right labeled "INFO". Click it and it shows info like BUS DEPARTURE TIMES and possibly the FACILITY it is taking place in.
 - Just below the four tabs is the name of the sport and school year. Make sure you are in the CURRENT school year.
 - Below the sport listing, there is a gray bar that includes - view all events, customize calendar, sign in, create account. Clicking here, you can SIGN UP and it will notify you of game cancellations.
